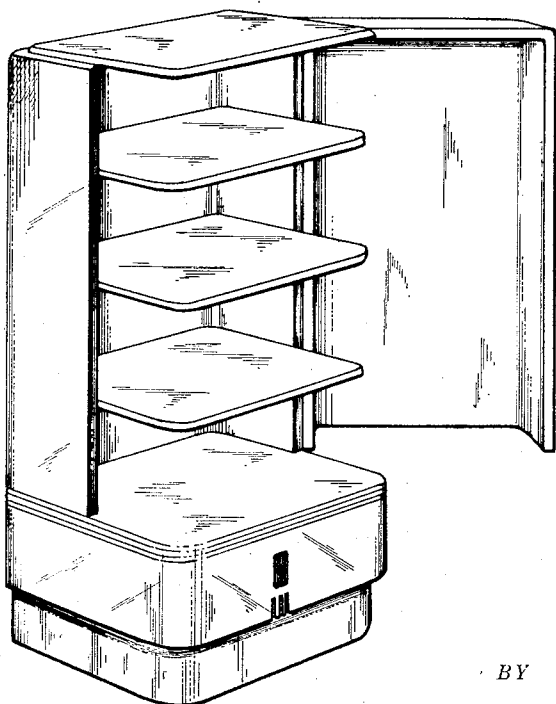
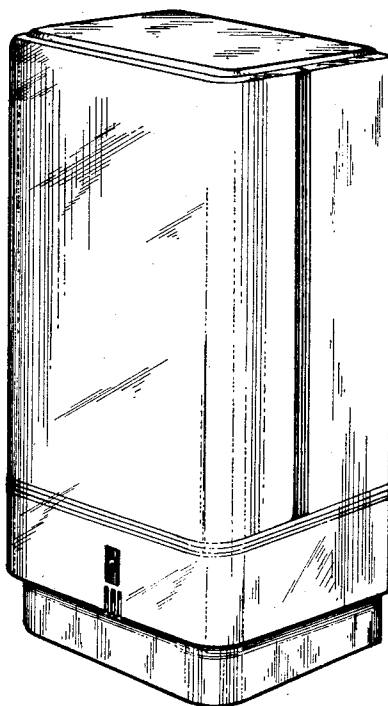

DESIGN FOR A REFRIGERATOR CABINET

Application filed February 16, 1932. Serial No. 42,890. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DONALD R. DOHNER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Refrigerator Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, constituting a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the refrigerator cabinet showing my new design; and,

Fig. 2 is a perspective view of the refrigerator cabinet shown with the door thereof open.
